Anaperenna Shiraz Cabernet 2009 Strong red-purple; a fragrant bouquet with blackberry, plum and blackcurrant swirling around each other; the palate is no more than medium bodied, but is intense and long, sustained by fine tannins on the very long finish. Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon. Cork. 14.5% alc. To 2024

Bishop Shiraz 2009 Dark purple-crimson; unashamedly full-bodied, laden to the gills with black fruits, dark chocolate, leather and mocha; will benefit from a minimum of 5 years in bottle and live for another 20. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. To 2029
